North Portico Takes Shape

You'll notice a new structure emerging on the church courtyard - the North Portico. Randy Heartfield and his scope of work team had discovered this feature as part of the original courtyard drawings from the 1940s but for unknown reasons, it was never built. As footings, beams and arches are erected, the third cloister flanking the sanctuary is finally coming to life completing the vision originated by our founding members.



Meanwhile, inside our sanctuary, a fresh palate of paint combined with energy-efficient lighting will bring a clean, warm ambience to our worship space. The wood paneling in the church lounge is currently undergoing sanding and re-staining to bring back it's original grain and luster. The business office now dons drywall, paint and new ceiling panels with up-to-date lighting and acoustics. Eventually new furniture will adorn the new offices and spacious, new reception area to welcome our visitors. (Anticipated move-in date is late October, early November.) Similarly, the upstairs clergy suite is also coming to life with a newly-built reception area, offices, and conference area. Much progress has made in the upstairs classrooms, hallways, bathrooms and robing rooms. The choir practice room will feature a state-of-the art audio/visual media system.
