## 2009 Mission Grant Recipients

***Angel Interfaith Network*** partners with L.A. County and USC Healthcare Network to meet unique physical and spiritual needs of patients and families with neighbor to neighbor support.

***Community Presbyterian Church***, West Covina: Foundation grant will fund the purchase of equipment to enable hearing-impaired parishioners to more fully participate in worship.

***Convalescent Aid Society*** improves the quality of life of residents in Pasadena and its neighboring communities through the free loan of wheelchairs and other medical equipment for in-home use.

***Ecumenical Council Pasadena Area Churches/Friends in Deed*** is a community leader striving to reduce poverty and homelessness in the Pasadena area through the support of a food pantry, bad weather shelter, and other programs.

***Five Acres*** is dedicated to helping families raise children to become caring and productive adults by building on their strengths and those of their families and communities.

***The Gooden Center's*** mission is to help alcohol and drug addicted men achieve lasting sobriety. It fulfills this mission through a treatment program that focuses on education, emotional, social and spiritual support.

***Habitat for Humanity*** is a nonprofit, ecumenical Christian housing organization building simple, decent, affordable housing in partnership with people in need.

***La Casa de San Gabriel Community Center*** is a family resource center for the multi-cultural community in the West San Gabriel Valley. The purpose of La Casa is to support individuals and families in need by providing direct human services, advocacy and referrals.

***Monte Vista Grove Homes*** is a residential ministry, dedicated to meeting the needs of qualified retirees of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.). It seeks to serve its residents within the context of a supportive, caring, Christian community providing for their spiritual, physical, social and emotional needs.

***Move A Child Higher, Inc.*** is a therapeutic horseback riding program that offers equine assisted activities to disabled riders, based in the Hahamongna Watershed Park in Pasadena.

***Villa Esperanza Services*** serves children and adults with developmental disabilities and vulnerable, at-risk adults and seniors in Los Angeles and Ventura Counties.
