August 1 - We're into week six!

The fumigation of San Marino Community Church went without a hitch. It looked like a circus had come to town for a few days then it all came down for an "air out" for remainder of the week. Meanwhile, because of the fumigation, Sunday's July 24th worship was held at Southwestern Academy with a picnic following the service. The outdoor amphitheater, shaded by beautiful oak trees was the perfect setting for an "off-campus" event. This past week with framing, electrical, plumbing and insulation complete, the dry wall is going in, making it easier to visualize the finished spaces. Furniture has been ordered in anticipation of moving staff into their new spaces by mid-October.

We will be starting work on the courtyard within the next few days, beginning with tree removal. Pathways will allow for safe passage around the perimeter of the courtyard. Coming up soon are painting in the sanctuary, as well updating the Bride's Room with new plumbing, fixtures, paint, carpeting and furniture.
